## **GENERAL INFORMATION & SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

- Read the Manual: Always read the user manual before using the soldering iron.
- Work Area: Ensure your workspace is well-ventilated, clean, and free of flammable materials.
- Safety Gear: Wear safety glasses and heat-resistant gloves.
- Electrical Safety: Check the power cord for damage before use. Do not use if damaged.
- Children and Pets: Keep the soldering iron out of reach of children and pets.

#### **BEFORE FIRST USE**

- 1. Inspect the Soldering Iron Check for any visible damage to the handle, cord, or tip.
- 2. Assemble the Stand Set up the soldering iron stand on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- 3. Attach the Tip Ensure the soldering tip is securely attached to the iron.
- 4. Tinning the Tip Plug in the soldering iron and let it heat up.
  - Apply a small amount of solder to the heated tip.
  - Wipe off excess solder with a damp sponge, leaving a shiny, tinned surface.

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Heating the Soldering Iron**

- Plug in the TS1465 soldering iron and turn it on (if applicable).
- Allow the iron to reach the desired temperature.

#### Soldering

- 1. Prepare Materials: Clean the components to be soldered.
- 2. Apply Flux: Use flux on the areas to be soldered to improve the flow of solder.
- 3. Heat the Joint: Place the soldering iron tip on the joint to heat it.
- 4. Apply Solder: Touch the solder to the heated joint, not the tip. The solder should melt and flow into the joint.
- 5. Remove the Iron: Once enough solder has been applied, remove the iron and let the joint cool.

#### **Turning Off**

Unplug the soldering iron after use and let it cool on the stand.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

#### **Cleaning the Tip**

- Regularly clean the tip with a damp sponge during use.
- Use a brass sponge or tip cleaner for more thorough cleaning.

#### Storing

Store the soldering iron in a cool, dry place after it has fully cooled.

#### **Replacing the Tip**

Replace the soldering tip when it becomes worn or damaged. Ensure the iron is unplugged and cool before replacing.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

lssue	Solution
Iron Not Heating	<ul> <li>Check the power connection.</li> <li>Ensure the iron is plugged in and switched on (if applicable).</li> </ul>
Solder Not Melting	<ul> <li>Verify the temperature setting (if applicable).</li> <li>Ensure the tip is clean and properly tinned.</li> </ul>
Poor Solder Joints	<ul><li>Check for proper heating and application of flux.</li><li>Ensure components are clean and free of oxidation</li></ul>

### WARRANTY
