REMOTE CONTROL

Power ON/OFF (Red Power Button)

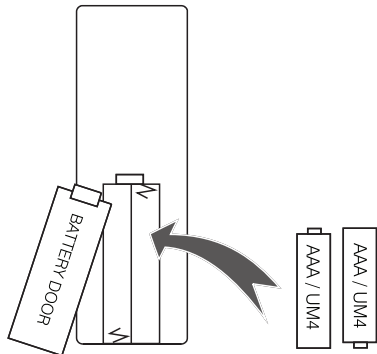

BATTERIES STATEMENT AND NOTICES (Batteries not included in the package)

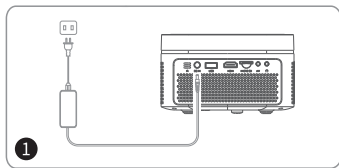
Remove the battery compartment cover on the back of your remote by carefully sliding to open. The battery cover can then be lifted away. Fit the correct batteries, referring to the polarity markings. Finally, replace the cover.

NOTE:

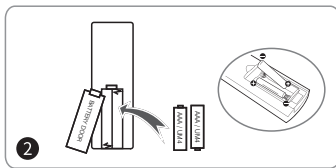
- When you receive the product and find that the batteries of the remote control is swollen or softened, please do not use it before you change it.
- Batteries shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire.
- Make sure that the batteries are installed polarity correctly.
- Only same or equivalent type batteries as recommend are to be used.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire, battery may explode or leak. Do not try to recharge a battery.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard(carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (ni-cad,ni-mh,etc) batteries.



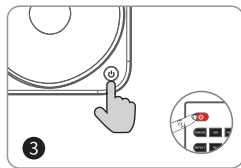
QUICK START



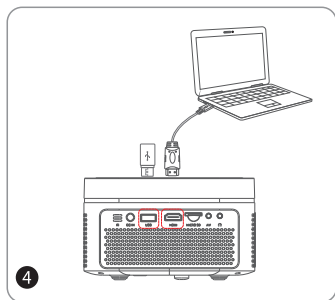
1 Plug the power Adaptor into an outlet.



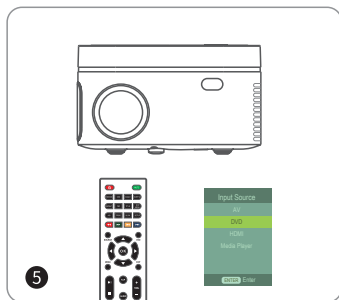
2 Install batteries in the remote control



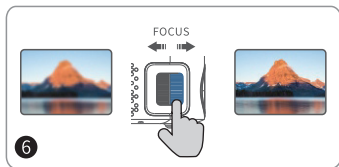
3 Press the **Power Button** to turn on the projector.



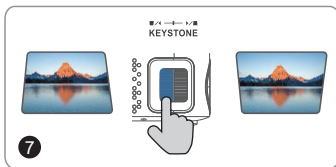
4 Connect your device to the projector correctly.



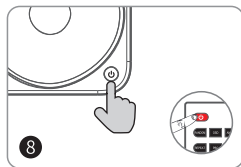
5 Use the remote control to select the correct input source.



6 Adjust the focus ring to get the best image performance.



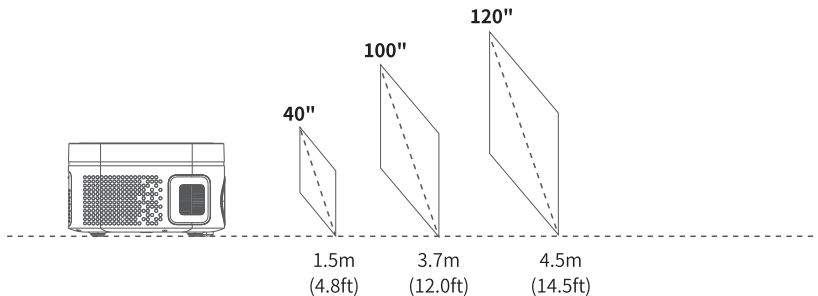
7 Adjust the keystone to get the suitable size

PROJECTION DISTANCE & SIZE

The recommended projection screen is around 80 inches with a distance of around 2.96M.
Ambient darkness will improve the clarity of the projected images.



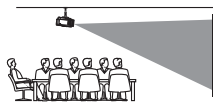
PROJECTION MODE

If you want to project in different way, please select corresponding mode in the setting page.



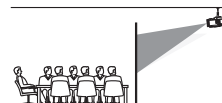

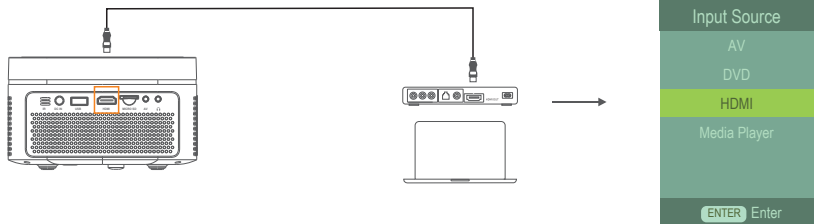

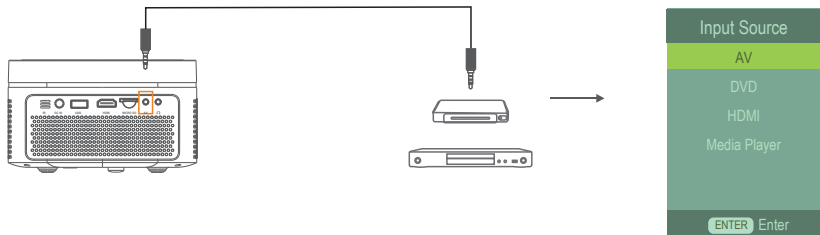
INPUT SOURCE

B. AV Connection

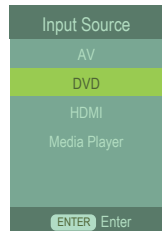

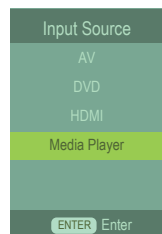
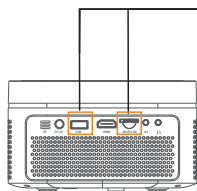

3. Please through Source button to exit DVD interface.



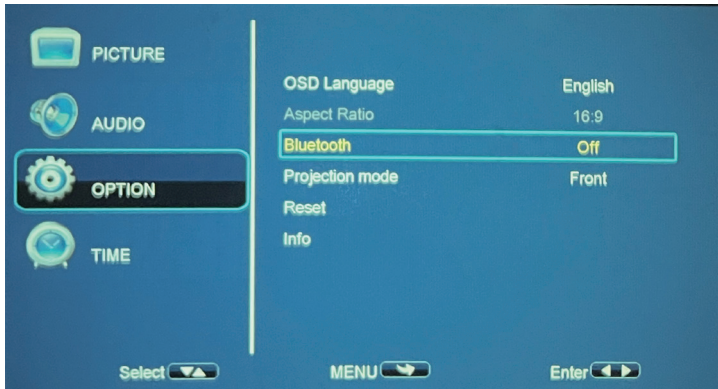

BLUETOOTH SETTING

Bluetooth Connecting

1. Go to **Set up page** > **Option** > **Bluetooth**
2. Turn the Bluetooth function **ON** and search for nearby Bluetooth devices.
3. Choose correct Bluetooth device to connect.



NOTE:

1. Bluetooth function is **ONLY** for audio transfer with audio devices, like Bluetooth speaker/headset/soundbar, NOT support video/audio sync with smartphone/Pad.
2. Due to compatibility issues with the Bluetooth protocol, some brands of Bluetooth speakers may not support connection to projectors.
3. Control the Bluetooth switch by the **left/ right** buttons on controller

Blurry Image?

- Adjust focus ring/keystone to get the best image.
- We recommend using it on a white wall or a good quality screen. Using it on a thin white gauze or cloth screen will reduce the image quality.

- Turn Dolby audio off in your device.
- The mute button on the remote was be pressed accidentally.

--Press "Flip" button on the remote control.

--Enter "Set UP -OPTION-Projection mode" to change the Projection Mode.
