- 5. In the event of mechanical damage, unplug the unit and call a service technician. Do not attempt to repair it yourself or remove the rear cover.

- * When the TV set will not be used for long periods of time, disconnect it from mains supply (or car outlet) as well as the antenna for your safety.
- * To prevent electric shock do not use this power plug with an extension cord, receptacle or other outlet unless the blades can be fully inserted to prevent blade exposure.

- 2) Keep these instructions.
- 3) Heed all warnings.
- 4) Follow all instructions.
- 5) Do not use this unit near water.
- 6) Clean only with a dry cloth.
- 7) Do not block any ventilation openings. Ventilation should not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings with items such as newspapers, table-cloths, curtains etc. There must be a minimum distance of 5cm clear space around the unit at all times to ensure proper ventilation.
- 8) Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat. No naked flame sources such as lit candles, should be placed on or near the unit.
- 9) Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles and the point where they exit from the unit.
- 10) Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- 11) Use only with a cart, stand, tripod, bracket or table specified by the manufacturer or sold with the unit. When a cart is used, use caution when moving the cart/unit combination to avoid injury from tip-over.
- 12) Unplug this unit during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.
- 13) Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Servicing is required when the unit has been damaged in any way, such as power-supply cord or plug is damaged, liquid has been spilled or objects have fallen into the unit, the unit has been exposed to rain or moisture, does not operate normally or has been dropped.
- **14)** The unit should not be exposed to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, should be placed on the unit.
- **15)** Place the television on a stable, flat surface. Failure to do so can result in the television falling, causing injury.
- **16)** Do not allow young children to play around or on the television. Do not hang from the unit Failure to do so can result in the television falling, causing injury.
- 17) Do not allow young children to play with the plastic bag that came with the television when you unpacked it. Failure to do so can result in suffocation, which may lead to death.
- **18)** Avoid improper installation and never position the unit where good ventilation is impossible. When installing this unit, distance recommendations must be maintained between the set and the wall, as well as inside a tightly enclosed area or piece of furniture. Keep to the minimum distance guidelines shown for safe operation.

19) Cautions for installation

- Do not tilt the unit left, right or towards the back.
- Ensure the power cord is out of the path of foot traffic.
- The unit will generate a slight amount of heat during operation. Ensure that sufficient space is available around the unit to allow satisfactory cooling.
- Have two people remove the unit from the box with the screen facing away from you. It's possible your clothing (such as a belt buckle or button) may scratch the front of the unit. Do the same when moving the unit to another location.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 20) Make enough room for inserting and removing the power plug. Place the unit as close to the outlet as possible. The main power supply for this unit is controlled by inserting or removing the power plug. Physically disconnecting the power plug is the only way to completely disconnect the unit from the mains power source.
- 21) Batteries must not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.
- 22) When this unit is connected to the wall outlet, it is always on standby even when all the LED lamps are not lit. To shut down the unit, unplug the unit from the wall outlet.
- 23) If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced before further use by the manufacturer, its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- **24)** Always place the TV on furniture that can safely support the TV.Make sure the ends of the TV do not hang over the edge of the supporting furniture.
- **25)** Do not place the TV on tall furniture (for example, cupboards or bookcases) without anchoring both the furniture and the TV to a wall or other suitably strong support.
- **26)** Do not stand the TV on cloth or other materials placed between the TV and the supporting furniture.
- 27) Where the mains adaptor is used as the disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable.
- **28)** This TV is suitable for use in caravans or similar covered locations. It is not designed to withstand harsh marine environments.

WARNING



STAND INSTALLATION

Your TV is packaged with the unit and the legs separate. Unless the TV is wall-mounted, the legs must be securely attached to the TV before use.

Step 1

Place the TV face down on a soft cloth or cushion to prevent the panel from being damaged.

Step 2

Align the screw holes on each Leg to the screw holes on the bottom of the TV.


Step 3

Attach the Legs to the TV using the 4x Screws provided.



REMOTE CONTROL PREPARATION

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Press and hold the arrow area on the back of Remote Control and pull outside to separate the back cover from the Remote Control.
- Insert two 1.5V AAA size batteries. Make sure to match the polarity markings (+/-) on the batteries with the indication inside the compartment.
- Install back the battery compartment cover.



(**Note:** For reference only! The appearance may vary depending on the model.)

Notes:

- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long time, remove the batteries.
- Replace batteries if the remote control does not work even when operated close to the TV.

REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION

Point the remote control from no more than approximate 5 meters and within 60° from the remote control sensor.

Notes

- The operating distance may vary according to the brightness of the room.
- Do not point bright light at remote control sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote control and the remote control sensor.
- Do not use this remote control while simultaneously operating the remote control of any other equipments.





Playing Sound through Bluetooth

Connect a smart device to the TV via Bluetooth to play sound from the smart device through the TV's speakers.

- 1. Connect the TV to the network.
- 2.Turn the smart device's Bluetooth on, then select the TV from the list of devices.
- 3. The TV will be connected to the smart device.

Note:

The TV may not be found in the list of smart devices while searching for a broadcast programme or setting up a Bluetooth speaker.

If you connect a smart device to the TV via Bluetooth and listen to the sound of the smart device through the TV speaker, the TV may not be connected to any other smart device.

Connect speakers or headphones to play TV sound.

- 1. Turn on the output speaker or headphones in Bluetooth mode.
- 2.Press 🕏 button on the remote control and select 🧔 Settings Sound Sound Out Use Wireless Speaker Bluetooth Device. Press OK Button to confirm.
- 3.Select the connectable Bluetooth device name and press OK to connect. Now you can play TV sound on an external speaker or Bluetooth headphones.

Initial Setup

Common operations for the initial setup:

When you turn on the TV first time, press OK button on remote control to connect to your TV as per the screen below.



Select the language

Press Navigation button to select desired language. Press RIGHT button to highlight "Next" and press OK to the next step.



Select "Skip" to go to next step directly, or select available wireless and input the password to connect to the network.





1.1 Select Mode

Vivid: Sharpens the image by increasing the contrast, brightness and sharpness.

Standard: Display the picture with natural contrast, brightness and sharpness levels.

Basic: The Energy Saver feature changes settings on the TV to reduce power consumption.

(The configurable items differ depending on model.)

Cinema: Suitable picture for movies.

Cricket: Suitable picture for sports games. Sharpens the image of rapid movements such as kicking or throwing a ball.



2. Sound



2.1 Sound Mode

Standard: Optimises the sound for all type of content.

Cinema: Optimises the sound for cinemas.

Clear Voice: Boosts voice clarity.

Cricket: Optimises the sound for sports games.

Music: Optimises the sound for music.

2.2 Sound Out

Select the TV internal speakers or external connected device as the sound output.

Note: This TV will output no sound if you have selected external connected device as the

sound output.

2.3 Advanced Settings

Adjust TV sound as you like.

3. General



3.1 Accessibility

Set up TV to fit individual needs to create a more convenient experience.

Accessibility - Subtitle

Highlight "Subtitle" and press OK button to enter the sub-page. Press OK button repeatedly to turn on or turn off the subtitle.

3.2 Al Service

Set the detailed options for the AI function.

3.3 Game Optimiser

Set up various features to enjoy the game more realistically. It only works with HDMI inputs.

3.4 Family Settings

To have a safe and healthy TV viewing environment, the following features are available: Usage Limits Settings, Eye Care Mode, Volume Limit Mode, and Screen Time Report.

3.5 Programmes

Set up and manage settings related to broadcast programmes.

Programmes - Programme Tuning - Auto Tuning)

Highlight "Auto Tuning" and press OK button to start auto tuning. (To get all available channels, the TV will need to be re-tuned erery time you are using it at a new location.)

3.6 Network

Set settings related to your wired/wireless network.

Highlight "Network" and press OK button to enter the sub-page.



Press navigation button to select Wired Connection or Wi-Fi Connection.

Wired Connection: If the router connected to the network supports the DHCP feature, connecting the TV and router by wire will automatically connect to the network. If the automatic setup is not supported, you can select Edit manually to set up the network connection.

Wi-Fi Connection: Select one available wireless Internet network, and input password to connect.

3.7 External Device


You can set up the TV and external devices connected to the TV.

3.8 System

Set language, Location, Time & Timer, Safety, etc.

System - Time & Timer - Timers - Auto Power Off after 4 Hours

Highlight "Auto Power Off after 4 Hours" and press OK button repeatedly to turn on or turn off the function.



System - Safety - Enable the function


Highlight "Enable the function" and press OK button to turn on or turn off the function. (Password is needed to turn on or turn off the function, and the initial password is "0000".)

TV Rating Locks: Prevents children from watching certain adult programmes, according to the ratings limit set.

Select None/Lock All/G/PG/M/MA/AV/P, and press OK button to confirm.

Programme Locks: Blocks the programmes that contain inappropriate contents for children.

Highlight "Programme Locks" and press OK button to enter the sub-page, select desired programme and press OK button to confirm your selection, then press RED button to lock it.



Application Locks: Restrict access to certain apps by setting up a password.

Highlight "Application Locks" and press OK button to enter the sub-page, select desired app and press OK button to lock it.

Input Locks: Restrict access to certain inputs by setting up a password.

Highlight "Input Locks" and press OK button to enter the sub-page, select desired input source and press OK button to lock it.

Reset Password: Setup a new password.

Highlight "Reset Password" and press OK button to enter the sub-page, input the initial password first to enter the "Set Password" menu, then input your new password twice and press OK.

System - Reset to initial Settings

Highlight "Reset initial Setting" and press OK button to enter the sub-page.

Select "Reset All": All items on the TV are changed to their default settings.

Select "Reset all except network settings" : All items except the network settings are changed to their default settings.





TV Guide

You can view programmes and the schedule of each programmes. In Live TV, press the GUIDE button on the remote control to enter the Guide interface.



- 1. Select each area to access the corresponding feature.
- 2. You can view information on the programme and broadcaster.
- 3. You can view information about the programme you are currently watching as well as the focused programme information.
- 4. Select the See Details item or the title of the desired programme. You can view more information on the programme and perform Watch/Record (only available on certain models) or Reminder/Scheduled Recording (only available on certain models), etc.
- 5. You will be taken to the programme list for the current date and time.
- 6. Learn more options.
- 7. Exit the TV Guide.

Recording

With the WebOS TV, you can use recording functions.

A USB memory device must be inserted into one of the USB ports for any recording.

Using Instant Recording

- 1. Connect a USB storage device (USB HDD, USB stick) to the USB port. (Note: Version 3.0, Min 32GB of memory for USB stick; Min 128G for USB HDD)
- 2. In Live TV, press "REC" button on remote control to call out the interface shown below.
- 3. Highlight "Done" and press OK to start recording. There is tool bar showing "Recording has started".



4. To stop the recording, press button on remote control to call out the tool bar as below, and select the option as you like.



Find the recording:

Press "···" button on remote control and highlight "Recordings", then press OK button to enter the recordings list.

Delete the recordings:

In the recordings list, highlight (Options) and press OK button to call out the option box, then select "Delete" and press OK button.

Tick the desired recording, and select "Delete".





Connecting USB

Connect a USB storage device (USB HDD, USB stick) to the USB port on the TV to enjoy the content files stored on the USB storage device on your TV.

(Min 32GB of memory for USB stick, and Min 128G for USB HDD)


Press \bigcirc and select your connected USB, press OK button and select "Media files" to enter the interface as below:



Highlight "All" and press OK button to call out the list, then press navigation button to select your preferred item: All/Photo & Video/Photo/Video/Music.

Home Dashboard

Press the 🕒 button on remote control. Select "Home Hub" and press OK button to open it.



(Note: The Home Dashboard of Smart TV may vary for different model.)

- 1. Displays the content of current source.
- 2. Wirelessly share content from your iPhone, iPad, or Mac. Make sure your device are on the same Wi-Fi or Ethernet network.
- 3. You can check and select the smart device connected with the ThinQ app.
- 4. You can check and select the input source.
- 5. You can connect and see devices registered with your ThinQ account. Once the device is connected, the card will be changed to a smaller size and appear at the bottom of the device connection list.
- 6. Log into your user account.
- 7. Learn more options.
- 8. Exit the Home Dashboard.

Note: Available settings vary depending on the model or region.

MAINTENANCE

- Be sure to press STANDBY button to set the player to the standby mode and disconnect the power plug before maintaining the player.
- If the surface is extremely dirty, wipe clean with a cloth which has been dipped in a weak soap-water solution and wrung out thoroughly, and then wipe again with a dry cloth.
- Never use alcohol, benzine, thinner, cleaning fluid or other chemicals. And do not use compressed air to remove dust.
- Wipe clean with a soft cloth only to avoid scratches.


