
Getting Started

The Coin Pusher uses 4 x D sized batteries.

- 1. Insert batteries in battery compartment.(Dia.A)
- 2. Place the unit on a firm levelled surface.
- 3. Before play to start, you can fill up the Coin Pusher by inserting coins through the 2 slots on the top.

There is a hatch in roof which allows you to feed in the coins faster. Simply use a screwdriver to open the hatch and replace it back on. after feeding in the coins.(Dia.B)

4. DO NOT put anything other than the coins into the machine.


You're Ready to Play

1. Now you can choose the setting of the Coin Pusher through the two control switchs at front


The control switch on the right is the "ON/OFF" switch incorporated with the "TILT MECHANISM". There is a choice of playing with the system on (Right) or off (Left). If you choose to play with the "TILT MECHANISM" on and when the machine is being tilted, the siren goes off together with flashing lights and the machine will then stop. Turn the switch to 'OFF' (Centre) and then to left or right again to continue the game .(Dia.C)

The control switch on the left let you choose the setting of the machine - with both lights and music (Centre), with lights only (Right) and less lights and with music (Left). You can change the setting any time during play.(Dia.D)

2. Now you can start to play by putting the coin through the 2 slots on the top and try to push as much coins down as possible. Use your skill to drop the coin at just the right time to push all the coins forward onto the lower shelf, and in turn hopefully push all the coins on that level over the edge as your reward!





Battery Instructions

- Use A Screwdriver to open the battery compartment.
- Use 4 x D sized batteries (not included).
- Switch toy off before inserting batteries.
- Non rechargeable batteries are not be recharged
- Rechargeable batteries should only be charged under adult supervision.
- Different types of batteries or old and new batteries are not to be mixed.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Do not short circuit the battery terminals.
- Do not want to throw into the battery to fire or dismantle the solution open their exterior packing.
- Batteries are harmful if swallowed, so keep away from young children.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged (if removable).
