GENERAL INFORMATION & SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Our Personal Alarm with 130dB is a compact, portable device that emits a loud and attention-grabbing alarm sound when activated. It is designed for personal safety and can be used in various situations, such as in case of an attack, medical emergency, or when you need to attract attention quickly.

- 130dB Siren: The alarm produces a piercing sound at 130 decibels to alert others and deter potential threats.

- LED Light: Some models include a built-in LED flashlight for added functionality.


NOTE: Place the product on a dry, flat, even surface when not in use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS


Please pull out the pin on the top of the equipment to activate the alarm; it will immediately flash. Insert the pin to stop the alarm. Holding the button turns on the LED light, and releasing it turns off the LED light.


1. Pull out the SOS pin to activate the alarm.

2. Insert the SOS pin to deactivate the alarm.




3. Hold the button to turn the LED light on, and release the button to turn it off.


REPLACING THE BATTERY




1. Unscrew the battery cover



2. Slide to remove the back cover.



3. Replace old batteries with new ones, observing polarity.



4. Install the back cover, following the indicated direction, and screw the battery cover in place.

CLEANING, CARE, STORAGE & MAINTENANCE

Cleaning: Regularly inspect the alarm for dirt, dust, or residue. Use a damp, lint-free cloth to gently clean the surface of the alarm. Avoid using abrasive or corrosive cleaning agents, as they may damage the device.
