WARNING: Don't place the probe in a high temperature environment (keep below 70°C).


BEFORE FIRST USE



OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

Press the host button for 3 seconds for power on, IPS screen indicator lights blue, press 3 seconds for power off.

LED Light Adjustment

After power on, the LED light is the brightest by default setting, press the button to adjust the brightness, the brightness is divided into 4 levels, and the fourth level is turning off the LED light.

Other Settings

In photo or video mode, press to set the "Resolution" and "Date Sticker", among which:

- Resolution can choose "VGA", "720P", "1080P".
- After the date sticker is turned on, when taking a photo or video, the date
 of the photo/video will be displayed in the lower right corner of the photo
 or video. In the photo or video mode, press to make the following
 settings:
- Automatic shutdown, you can choose setting "off" or "3 minutes", "5 minutes" and "10 minutes", Automatic shutdown after minutes; d.Language setting, support "Simplified Chinese", "Traditional Chinese", "Japanese", "English", "Korean", "French", "German", "Russian" and "Spanish", default "English".

Charging

Connect the device to the charger (DC5V) wiht Type-C cable for charging, The device does not support fast charging

WARNING: Inspection camera can't be used while charging.

COPYING PHOTOS




A: Copy to computer using TF card

B: Connect the computer with data cable, borescope power on.

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Unscrew the handle battery screw cover and take out the battery,
- 2. Please pay special attention that the positive and negative poles of the battery correspond to the positive and negative poles on the endoscope handle. After fixed, close the battery cover and Tighten the screw.



NOTE: Before replacing the battery, please make sure the device is dry and shut down.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Fault	Possible Causes	Method
Does not charge	The charging USB cable or plug is dirty. Damaged charging cable.	Clean the USB plug and cable. Replace the charging cable or charger.
Blurry Image	 The camera is dirty. Camera is not within the range of the depth-of-field. Damaged lens due to high temperature. 	 Clean the camera with a lint-free cloth. Please place the probe within the depth of field range of 20-100 mm. Do not place the camera in a high temperature environment (above 50 °C).
The camera movement range is too small	Camera is distorted	Please straighten the camera neck and try again.
Unable to Power- on	1.Dead Battery 2.Incorrect Installation	1.Please recharge or replace the battery. 2.Please check the battery and battery compartment contact if it is dirt or deformation, then reinstall the battery
Auto Power-off	Low Battery	Please recharge or replace the battery.
Boot screen stuck 1. Failed to start the system. 2.Low Battery.		1.Long press "Reset" button. 2.Reassemble the battery and restart it, then charge it.
Image cannot be recorded or found	SD card capacity is insufficient.	1.Replace the SD card or delete unnecessary files. 2.Formatting the SD Card.
