
BEFORE FIRST USE

PREPARATION

- 1. Charge caliper till fully charged, power indicator will turn green when fully charged. Refer to product overview of caliper for location of charging indicator.
- 2. Loosen locking screw on the top of the caliper.
- 3. Wipe the caliper.
- 4. Check all the buttons function.
- 5. Check the caliper head moves freely.
- 6. Set to zero by pressing the "zero" this clears the screen to zero.
- 7. It's now ready to measure.



FAILURE	REASON	SOLUTION
Five digits appear simultancously and change rapidly	Battery power low	Charge it as soon as possible
Reading error for full length is ≤0.1mm	Dirt has damaged/ covered sensor	Remove cover and slidler assembly. Wipe with a clean cloth and lubricate
Nothing appears on the LCD	Battery is dead	Charge for up to 1 hour
