



Installing the Batteries

Remove the battery cover from the rear of the Remote Control and place 2xAAA size batteries inside the compartment.

Please make sure the battery polarities match the polarity markings inside the compartment.



Using the Remote Control

To use the Remote Control, point it towards the front of the Digital Set Top Box. The Remote Control has a range of up to 7 metres from the Set Top Box at an angle of up to 60 degrees




The Remote Control will not operate if its path is blocked.



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

- POWER BUTTON: Push to turn on/off the main power supply. CHANNEL DOWN: Used to change channels without using the Remote Control. CHANNEL UP: Used to change channels without using the Remote Control. LED DISPLAY SCREEN⁽⁷⁾: Used to display channel number or time.

2. Rear panel



- (1) RF IN: This socket connects to your external Aerial.
- (2) RF LOOP THROUGH: This socket will feed the RF signal to either your TV or another video system.

2.2 Electronic programs guide (EPG)


You can press [EPG] button on the remote controller to enter into the EPG page to know more about the programs to be played. As shown in the figure below There are several mode: Now/Next Mode, Daily Mode, Weekly Mode, Default is Now/Next Mode, Press red button can switch mode. Press 『EXIT』 or 『EPG』 button to quict EPG menu.



There are 7 parts:

- Label 1 part show current EPG status;
- Label 2 part show current time and program information
- Label 3 part show detail date list;
 Label 4 part show channel list, Press "UP/DOWN." button can switch different
- channels. Press PAGE-/+ J button to switch in different page:
- Label 5 part show current play program information (Now Event) , Press r
 "UP/DOWN_ button can switch NOW and NEXT status;
- Label 6 part show the program information of next time slot (Next Event) ;
 Label 7 part show button hint information;
 Red button: Enter into Daily Mode
 Green button: Record label 5 part program of bookmark label 6 part program
- Press 『INFO』 button can show detail inform

Problem	Potential Reasons	What to do	
Nopicture	Power isn't connected	Connect the power	
	The power switch is not on	Switch on the power	
Screen shows "No Signal"	DVB-T2 cable not connected	Plug in the DVB-T2 cable	
	Aerial cable is faulty	Check aerial cable and connections	
No sound from speaker	No or incorrect connection with audio cable	Connect the audio cable correctly	
	Sound on mute	Turn off mute function	
Only sound, no image on the screen	Resolution not supported by TV set.	Press V-FORMAT button to change resolution.	
	No or incorrect connection with AV cable	Make sure cables are connected correctly
