

**Please note:** When you use the Voice Search function in Apps, please press the microphone knob on the remote to activate, then press and hold the microphone to speak.


#### 2.2 Using your mobile phone to control the box

For IOS: Download "Android TV Remote" from the APP store.


For Android: Download "Android TV Remote" from Google Play store.


Once you have downloaded the app, open it up, select "XC6010" and follow the prompts. Enter the code that pops up on the screen to pair your phone with the box.


## 3.1 Installation guide






No	Item	Description
1	TF(SD card)	For your local storage device
2	USB HOST	Connects to an USB device.
3	USB OTG	Connects with a keyboard, mouse, or other USB device.
4	DC 5V	Connects to a power adapter.
5	HD	Connects the TV box to the TV set through HDMI cable
6	AV Out	CVBS video & L/R audio out; Connects to non-HDTV and/or speakers.
7	LAN	Rj45 Lan port for TV box internet connection
8	SPDIF	Coaxial digital audio output; Connects to amplifier.


## 3.2 Connect TV box to TV and connect network




1 Connect TV Box to TV



2 Connect Network




3 Connect to external devices such as a keyboard, mouse, USB drive, game controller, etc. through these two USB ports.




#### 3.3 Set up your TV box

## 3.4 Sign into your account


You will be asked to sign into your account by either using your phone or laptop or by using your password. If you have not as yet created a Google account, then select "Use your Phone or Laptop" to create one. If you already have a Google account, then select the option "Use your Password".

## 4.1 Google assistant




## 4.1.1 Setting up the language for voice commands

Choose your preferred language in settings when pairing your remote to a movie or TV show. For example, if you want to watch a movie or TV show in French, the default language needs to be set to French. You also then need to speak in French when inputting the voice commands.




#### 4.1.2 Operating voice commands

Press and hold the voice button on the remote control. Do not release until you have inputted a voice command. For example, if you are searching for information relating to KODI, input the voice command "KODI". All information relating to this subject will pop up. You can use voice search in the Main interface, on YouTube, Play Store as well as All Apps.




#### 4.2 Preloaded Apps


## 4.3 Settings, Internet status and the App drawer

#### 4.3.1 Device setting


WiFi and Ethernet details can be found under the Network section.




Sound: Set the sound of the system.


App: When selecting App, you will be able to view all Apps preloaded onto the box. Select the required App, and then you can either open it, force stop or unistall the App.




Screen Saver: Go to App Drawer and select "BurnKeyTool" App. Once a key is successfully burnt, reboot your device.




About: In this section, all information pertaining to your TV box can be found.




Advance Setting - Display - Screen Resolution: Select the correct screen resolution according to your TV.

From this section, you can customize your preferred Date & Time, Language, Keyboard, Home Screen, Search, Speech and Accessibility settings.


#### 4.3.3 Remote & accessories

You can add accessories through Bluetooth by clicking "Add Accessory", or you can unpair the remote by clicking the remote icon.




## 4.3.4 Personal setting



#### 4.5 App Drawer


By clicking this icon, all Apps loaded onto the TV box can be viewed.




## **Chapter 5 - How to Install / Uninstall Apps**


5.1 How to install Apps from the Play store or through an APK installer.

Open the "Play Store" and search for the Apps you want to install, then click "Install".




Alternatively, you can install Apps via a hard drive. Insert the external hard drive into the USB port of the Android box, it will be recognized immediately and ES File Explorer will pop up automatically. Press OK to enter and select the App you intend to install, then press OK and wait until the installation is complete.





#### 5.2 How to uninstall Apps

Open "Play Store"-"My apps", and you will be able to see all of the Apps you have installed. Click on the App you want to uninstall, then click on the "Uninstall" option.




## **Chapter 6: Browse**

## Chapter 8: Tips on pairing your remote

If the Bluetooth remote won't pair with your android TV box, try the troubleshooting steps below:

#### 8.1 Connecting the TV box to a keyboard


Connect the Android TV box to a keyboard or mini wireless keyboard via the USB port. Press ESC key on the keyboard and enter into the system's initial boot interface (Please use the Up & Down arrows and Enter key on the keyboard to finish pairing).



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## 8.2 Add accessory


Select Settings, then scroll down to select "Remote & Accessory". Select "Add Accessory" to search for Bluetooth devices.






## 8.3 Activating pairing mode

To activate pairing mode, press and hold both the V- and PG- buttons on the remote for 5 to 10 seconds simultaneously.



## 8.4 Pairing

The TV box will find the Bluetooth control device, then press **Enter** to start pairing.



## 8.5 Pairing completed

Use the Bluetooth remote to navigate the box once pairing is successful.

# **Chapter 9: Troubleshooting**

Problem	Solution
Netflix Error NW-6-404	– Go to App Drawer and find the "BurnKeyTool" App and click yes. After burning a key successfully, reboot the device. This should solve the problem.
Other Netflix Error	- Reboot the device.
No Power	- Check if the power adaptor is properly connected to the power and the TV box .  - Press the power on the remote control to turn on the power.
Blank Screen on Startup	<ul> <li>Check that the power cable is not damaged and is securely attached to both the device and the power outlet</li> <li>Check that the HDMI cable is not damaged and is securely attached to both the device and the TV.</li> <li>Press the Source power button on your TV remote until you reach the source that your device is set to.</li> </ul>
No Audio	<ul> <li>Press the mute button on both the remote for the unit, and the remote for the TV.</li> <li>Check that all cables are securely plugged in and are not damaged or bent.</li> <li>Turn the unit off, wait 10 seconds and turn it back on again.</li> <li>Try another set of audio cables.</li> <li>Try another TV.</li> </ul>
No Picture	- Reconnect with HDMI cable or AV cable.  - Check if the TV set is switched on.
Player does not respond to the remote control	<ul> <li>Aim the remote control directly at the sensor on the front of the TV box.</li> <li>Reduce the distance to the TV box.</li> <li>Replace the batteries in the remote control.</li> </ul>

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The contents of the USB flash drive can't be read	<ul> <li>The USB flash drive format is not compatible with the box</li> <li>If one of the USB's is not ready, please turn off the TV box for 30 seconds and reboot the TV box.</li> </ul>
The TV screen is black and the player's LED indicator is blinking	<ul> <li>Turn off your TV box, wait 30 seconds, turn it on again.</li> <li>If under HDMI status, check if HDMI connection is correct or change the HDMI cable, set the HDMI output of this TV box to 720P.</li> </ul>
Apps that constantly crash/stop working	<ul><li>Uninstall the App.</li><li>Reinstall the App from the Play Store App.</li></ul>
